## RESERVATION WIDE BURN BAN ISSUED

## August 3, 2020

## THIS BAN IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY AND UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE

Bureau of Indian Affairs and Warm Springs Tribes has declared a Reservation Wide Burn Ban. The Warm Springs Reservation is in <u>"Extreme Fire Danger"</u> conditions. According to information provided by Warm Springs Fire Management and the National Weather Service, our region is in a fire weather watch situation that includes low relative humidity and gusty winds which increase fire danger. With dry fuel conditions and persistent drought and potential lack of water for fire suppression, it is critical we take precautions to help protect the people, property and resources of the Warm Springs Reservation.

## A BURN BAN MEANS:

1. All outside agricultural and residential burning is NOT allowed.

This includes weed burning, burn barrels, and burn bins.

2. Outdoor camp fires are not allowed in a declared burn ban.

Only cooking in BBQ (propane) or camp cooking stove is allowed.

3. All ceremonial and traditional fires are exempt from this burn ban.

Recommendation by Warm Springs Fire Management Prevention should be considered before burning.
