NOVEMBER 23, 2021

1. The meeting was called to order at 9:10 by Chairman Raymond Tsumpti, Sr.
ROLL CALL: Chief Joseph Moses, Lincoln Jay Suppah, Glendon Smith, Wilson Wewa, Jr., Anita Jackson, Lola Sohappy (phone), Raymond 'Captain' Moody (9:30). Minnie Yahtin, Recorder.
2. Blood Quantum - Lucille Suppach-Sampson, Vital Statistics:
 - Motion by Anita adopting Resolution No. 12,882 hereby authorizes the Warm Springs Tribal Enrollment officer to have W. Foster Sahme's Warm Springs Wasco Yakama blood quantum become 25/64 Yakama; Second by Joe; Question; Glendon/yes, Joe/yes, Jay/yes, Anita/yes, Wilson/yes, Lola/yes, 6/0/0, Chairman not voting; Motion carried.
 - Motion by Anita adopting Resolution No. 12,883 hereby directs that Samantha Rae Same Warm Springs, Wasco, Umatilla and Yakama blood quantum become 19/32 Yakama; Second by Joe; Discussion; Glendon/yes, Joe/yes, Jay/yes, Anita/yes, Wilson/yes, Lola/yes, 6/0/0, Chairman not voting; Motion carried.
3. 2022 Budget Resolution - Glendon Smith & Glendon Smith:
 - The Secretary-Treasurer will present the 2022 Budget, Senior Pension, Per Cap, Scholarship, Forest Management Deduction and 122 Budget Resolutions next Monday, November 29th.
4. Appeals Court Judges - Glendon Smith:
 - Votes were by Secret Ballot.
 - Motion by Wilson adopting Resolution No. 12,884, pursuant to Article V, Section (1) of the Constitution and By-Laws and 203.001 of the Warm Springs Tribal Code that: Thomas Weathers, James David Williams, Richard Uffleman, and Anthony Broadman/Chief Appellate Judge; The Tribal Council hereby appoints the Appeals Court Judges for the Warm Springs Court of Appeals, and are appointed for a (3) year term by Tribal Council and that per 203.100(5) during the first year from their initial appointment appeals court judges shall be on a probationary status, during the probationary period, appeals court judges may be removed from the bench at any time without cause by Tribal Council, Further, failure to pass the Tribal bar examination during the first (6) months on the bench will result in immediate disqualification from hearing cases and, if not corrected within (90) days, automatic removal from the bench; That each of the judges shall be compensated at the rate of \$150.00 per hour for the time they spend serving as Judge; Second by Glendon; Discussion; Glendon/yes, Joe/yes, Captain/yes, Jay/yes, Wilson/yes, Lola/yes, 6/0/0, Chairman not voting; Motion carried.
